Terms and Conditions

Youth Concern 10km Charity Walk – Coombe Hill

General

- The Youth Concern 10KM charity walk starts and finishes at Witchell Pavilion, The Witchell, Wendover, Bucks, HP226EG [Map Link](#)
- Date of the Charity Walk on **Sunday 6th January 2019**.
- Registration on the day will open at 9.30am.
- All entry fees are non-refundable and non-transferrable.
- If you have registered for the Charity Walk and find that for any reason you are unable to take part, please let us know as soon as possible. You must not give your place to anyone else and must return any completed sponsorship forms.

Participant entry

- The Youth Concern 10KM Coombe Hill charity walk is open to participants of all ages. Participants who are under 16 must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Anyone registering children under 16 must ensure they have parental consent for each child to participate.
- The Youth Concern Charity Walk is open to all ages and is priced at £20 for adults, £10 for children (under 16's) for advanced booking or £25 for adults, £12 for children on the day.
- Entry fees includes a walkers' pack, bacon bap with refreshments at the finishing point and water along the route.
- Online registration for the event will be open until midnight on 30th December 2018
- Unfortunately, due to the terrain of the route the event is not suitable for wheelchair or pushchair users.
- All Participants must abide by the country code
 - Remember to close all gates behind you
 - Dogs must be kept on a lead
 - Take all rubbish home with you

Health and safety

- If you are in doubt about your health or have a medical condition that could be affected by exercise, you should obtain your doctor's approval before participating in the Youth Concern Charity Walk
- By taking part in the event, you understand that Youth Concern are not liable for your health or possessions before, during, or after the event and that you participate at your own risk.
- We reserve the right to refuse entry to the event at our absolute discretion with no refund provided, if for whatever reason we consider a person unfit to take part.
- You must take responsibility for your dog/s and keep them on a lead at all times.
- You're responsible for your own safety and for others in your care – especially children - so be prepared for natural hazards, changes in weather and other events. Wild animals, farm animals and horses can behave unpredictably if you get too close, especially if they're with their young - so give them plenty of space.

- Emergency contact and medical details will be deleted after the event.
